RESOLUTION 2020-024

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE REGHETTO STORMWATER VAULT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City has identified the water quality swale north of SW Reghetto Street to be deficient and in need of replacement with a water quality vault; and

WHEREAS, the City completed the design and produced bid documents to solicit contractors using a competitive bidding process meeting the requirements of local and state contracting statutes and rules; and

WHEREAS, the City opened bids on April 16, 2020 and issued the Notice of Intent to Award with the mandatory seven (7) day protest period being completed; and

WHEREAS, the City has budgeted for the construction cost of this project within the FY2019-20 budget; and

WHEREAS, Banzer Construction Company has been identified by City staff as the lowest responsive bidder; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends City Council to authorize the City Manager to execute a construction contract with the lowest responsive bidder from the April 16, 2020 bid opening (Banzer Construction Company) in a Base Contract Amount of \$104,033 with Construction Contingency of \$15,604.95 (15%) of the Base Contract Amount for the Reghetto Stormwater Vault Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract with the lowest responsive bidder (Banzer Construction Company) in a Base Contract Amount of \$104,033 with Construction Contingency of \$15,604.95 (15%) of the Base Contract Amount for the Reghetto Stormwater Vault Project.

Section 2: This Resolution shall be in effect upon its approval and adoption.
