

RESOLUTION 2020-030

DECLARING THE NEED TO ACQUIRE INTERESTS IN CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Sherwood City Charter confers upon the City authority to acquire property for public purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized by ORS 223.105 to acquire, by condemnation if necessary, interests in real property for sanitary sewer systems; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized by ORS 223.005(1) to appropriate any private real property to any public or municipal use or for the general benefit and use of the people of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City needs to complete the Rock Creek Trunk line project due to capacity issues resulting from the site development of the Tonquin Employment Area (TEA), as well as conditions issues; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it necessary and in the public interest to acquire temporary construction and permanent public utility easements in the properties described in "Exhibits A" (TL# 2S129A000400), "Exhibit B" (LT# 2S129D000150), and "Exhibit C" (TL# 2S129A000300) attached hereto and incorporated herein, for the purpose of constructing and maintaining a public sanitary sewer trunk line; and

WHEREAS, it appears to City Council that the proposed use, improvement, or project as described above is planned or located in a manner which will be most compatible with the greatest public good and the least private injury; and

WHEREAS, the City anticipates commencing use of the above-described property within ten years of the date of adoption of this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

The Sherwood City Council hereby finds and declares that it is necessary and in the public interest that the City acquire temporary construction and permanent public utility easements in the properties described in "Exhibit A" (TL# 2S129A000400), "Exhibit B" (TL# 2S129D000150), and "Exhibit C" (TL# 2S129A000300), attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, for the purpose of constructing and maintaining a public sanitary sewer trunk line, a public or municipal use and for the general benefit and use of the people of the City, as authorized by the City Charter and ORS 223.105 and 223.005(1).

- Section 2. The Sherwood City Council further finds and declares that the proposed use described above is necessary and that the proposed use, improvement or project described herein is planned or located in a manner which will be most compatible with the greatest public good and the least private injury.
- Section 3. The Sherwood City Council further finds and declares that the City anticipates commencing use of the above-described property within ten years of the date of adoption of this Resolution.
- The Sherwood City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager, his designees, and the City Attorney, and his designees, to attempt to reach agreement with the owners and other persons with interest in the real property described herein as to the compensation to be paid for the appropriation of the properties, and in the event that no satisfactory agreement can be reached, the City Attorney, or designee, is directed and authorized to commence and prosecute to final determination such proceedings as may be necessary to acquire the real property and interest therein, and that upon filing of such proceeding, possession of the real property and interest therein may be taken immediately to the extent provided by law.

Section 5. This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
