RESOLUTION 2021-015

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE DIVISION STREET PAVEMENT AND STORM REHABILITATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City has identified the pavement on SW Division Street (from the Snyder Park Access to 250 feet west of SW Cuthill Place) to be deficient and in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified the storm sewer on SW Division Street (from 100 feet west of the Snyder Park Access to 250 feet west of SW Cuthill Place) to be deficient and in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, the City completed the design and produced bid documents to solicit contractors using a competitive bidding process meeting the requirements of local and state contracting statutes and rules (ORS 279C, OAR 137-049); and

WHEREAS, the City opened bids on March 11, 2021 and issued a Notice of Intent to Award with a mandatory seven (7) day protest period, which is currently in process; and

WHEREAS, the City has budgeted for the construction cost of this project within the FY2020/2021 budget; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends City Council authorize the City Manager to execute a construction contract with the lowest responsive bidder from the March 11, 2021 bid opening with Construction Contingency of 15% of the Base Contract Amount.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract upon the completion of the seven (7) day protest period with the lowest responsive bidder from the March 11, 2021 bid opening with Construction Contingency of 15% of the Base Contract Amount for the Division Street Pavement and Storm Rehabilitation Project.

Section 2: This Resolution shall be in effect upon its approval and adoption.
