

Proclamation Arbor Day, April 28, 2023

WHEREAS, in 1872, the first Arbor Day was observed in Nebraska with the planting of more than a million trees; and

WHEREAS, Arbor Day is now observed throughout the nation and the world; and

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon has decreed that the first full week of April shall be designated as Arbor Week; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood has been a Tree City USA since 2005; and

WHEREAS, the City is committed to urban forestry as a partner in Clean Water Services' Tree for All campaign, a collaborative effort to plant native trees and shrubs in the Tualatin River Basin; and

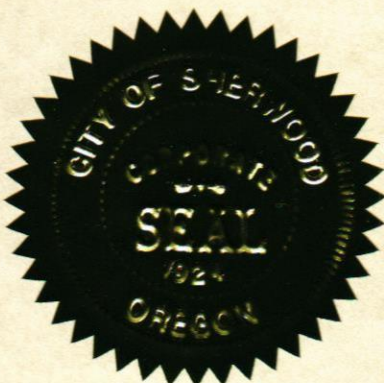


WHEREAS, having beautiful trees planted in our community is important to our citizens.
