

Proclamation National Police Week, May 12-18, 2024 and May 15, 2024 as National Police Officers Memorial Day

WHEREAS, The Congress and President of the United States have designated the week of May 12-18, 2024 as National Police Week; and

WHEREAS, The women and men of the Sherwood Police Department provide a vital public service by safeguarding the rights and freedoms of the Sherwood community; and

WHEREAS, it is important that all citizens know and understand the duties, responsibilities, hazards and sacrifices of their police department and that members of our police department recognize their duty to serve the people by safeguarding life and property, protecting them against violence and disorder and protecting the innocent against deception and the weak against oppression; and

WHEREAS, the safety of our citizens is the foremost goal of local, state and national governments; and

WHEREAS, the ability to exercise the rights and freedoms as set forth by our Forefathers depends upon law and order; and

WHEREAS, Law Enforcement is one of the few chosen professions that require the willingness to lay down one's life to protect others; and

WHEREAS, the daily performance of a Police Officer's normal duty is dangerous, stress-filled, often unappreciated and requires a person with a supportive family; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the Sherwood City Council, do hereby proclaim May 12-18, 2024 as National Police Week and May 15, 2024 as National Peace Officers Day in Sherwood and urge all citizens to recognize and thank Law Enforcement Officers for the dedicated service they provide.
