



RESOLUTION 2024-031

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER PRO TEM TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BLACKLINE, INC. FOR THE 2024-25 SLURRY SEAL PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City has a responsibility to maintain the City's infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City partnered with the City of Hillsboro to include Sherwood's 2024-25 Slurry Seal program in their Request for Proposal (RFP) for the same services; and

WHEREAS, the RFP process identified Blackline, Inc. as the lowest responsible bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager Pro Tem is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Blackline, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$167,573.00.

Section 2. Subject to the limitations of local and state contracting rules, the City Manager Pro Tem is hereby authorized to execute contract change order(s) for an amount not to exceed \$16,757.30 (10% of the original award) for a total contract amount not to exceed \$184,330.30.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
