OVERVIEW

The meeting covered several important updates and initiatives affecting the community. Mike Schultz announced his resignation from the board after four years, due to scheduling conflicts. The board approved the minutes from the previous meeting and welcomed Officer Jameson Angelel, who is set to attend the police academy alongside another recruit, Officer Jessica Teran. Officers Humphrey and Caraway were promoted to sergeant positions. In response to budget challenges, discussions on potential funding mechanisms for police services were initiated, which may include exploring fees or levies. The board reviewed traffic safety data, highlighting high crash rates at key intersections, and updated members on legislative changes allowing police drones to operate more effectively within a 2-mile radius. Additionally, council members are monitoring housing bills that threaten local control, and plans for a Youth Advisory Board aimed at high school students were approved. Upcoming community events were announced, including a Drug Take Back/Shred event, a 'Bowling with a Cop' night, and National Police Week celebrations.

NOTES

Board Membership Change

- Mike Schultz submitted his resignation due to work schedule conflicts after serving 4 years.

Minutes Approval

- The board approved minutes from the March meeting.

New Officer Introduction

- Officer Jameson Angelel was introduced; he and Jessica Teran are heading to the police academy on Monday.

Police Promotions

- Officers Humphrey and Caraway were promoted to sergeant positions.

Funding Discussion

- Board to explore potential police funding mechanisms (fees/levies) in response to budget challenges.

Traffic Safety Data

- Review of crash statistics showing 30 crashes at 99/Roy Rogers and 66 crashes at 99/Sunset over three years.

Drone Program Update

Legislative changes will allow police drones to fly within a 2-mile radius without requiring an observer.

Legislative Updates

- The City Council is tracking housing bills that could erode local control.

Youth Advisory Board

- The City Council approved the first reading to create a Youth Advisory Board for high school students.
